
Dear Mr. Klinger:

I am pleased to offer this letter of support for the proposed memorial in honor of the American liberators of the Buchenwald Concentration Camp.

April 11, 2020 will mark the 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the liberation of the Buchenwald Concentration Camp by American Armed Forces. Over 200,000 prisoners from all over Europe were held in Buchenwald between 1937 – 1945 and over 50,000 were executed. As time moves on from these atrocities, it is important that we never forget their occurrence and that we educate further generations.
