Wednesday, September 28. Arrive in Oklahoma City and check in to the Hampton Inn Bricktown. Welcome Reception in the hotel CP.

Thursday, September 29. Following breakfast at the hotel, depart for the 45th Inf Div Museum. Enjoy a tour of the Museum, followed by lunch at the Oklahoma History Center. After lunch, the afternoon is yours to tour the Center at your leisure. The evening is free. An optional dinner will be arranged at Cattlemen's Steakhouse in historic Stockyards City if there is enough interest.

Friday, September 30. Another breakfast at the hotel then depart for the National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum. After lunch, the afternoon is free for R & R or an optional canal ride on a water taxi and view of the Centennial Land Run Monument. In the evening you will be cruising' along the Oklahoma River. Dinner is on your own.

Saturday, October 2. Following breakfast we are off to visit the Myriad Botanical Gardens and view the flora and fauna of Oklahoma, and the Crystal Bridge Tropical Conservatory-a 7-story cylinder suspended over a lake the size of a football field. Lunch is available on the grounds. We will continue with a visit to the American Banjo Museum with over 400 banjos on display worth over \$3.5 Million. That evening we will eat dinner at the museum and be entertained by the Okie Dokie Banjo Band, the pride of Oklahoma and the same group with which our own 6AD veteran, Don Thomas, performed for many, many years.

Sunday, October 2. Enjoy one last breakfast at the hotel before bidding farewell to Oklahoma City and your 6th Armored Division friends.
